- Introduce the witness
- How to control the witness
- Break testimony into small pieces: use short questions
- Minimize exposure on Cross – give jury & witness ammunition on Direct
- Don't allow the witness to be the advocate in the courtroom
- The longer the trial, the less important is the closing argument
- Polling jurors
- Read back testimony from the trial transcript

Purpose of closing: give your allies on the jury ammunition to fight for your case
The use of exhibits
Thank the jurors
Do not deviate from the organization of your closing


