2. MINISTRY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

SCJ Guidelines to determine the mode of proceeding in Civil, Family, Criminal and Small Claims Court came into effect on April 19, 2022. Chief Justice Morawetz, on March 17, 2022, explained the documents would be reviewed in the New Year after the Bench and Bar had some time to work with them.

Accordingly the Office of the Chief justice is seeking input on the Guidelines. Consideration of all justice participants' needs a careful and thoughtful balance between the continued availability of both in-person and virtual attendances.
