Case Center is currently used by Ontario Courts to offer digital documents for both judges, lawyers and all participants in the trial.

- Welcome to CaseLines (now Case Center) Introductory video
- Currently used by the Ontario Superior Court (SCJ) and Court of Justice (OCJ) – click the links to see additional information from the Courts including FAQs
- Almost 4 k cases a month are run by the courts using it
- Dependent on Wi-Fi signals in courts since it a cloud-based system
